Please provide a brief summary of your role, the project you are supporting and the type of work you undertake on a daily basis:

So far in my traineeship I have been in the Commercial Department and I am now working in Engineering.

In the Commercial Department I worked on payment certificates and payment notices. One of my main tasks was making sure employees from ISS and Power Testing, Balfour Beatty's subcontractors, get paid.

I am currently working on the project SSR 3A, the same contract as when I was in the Commercial Department. This includes working on the substations on the District Line of the London Underground. I am working on relay panels that will be put into the substations and the control cabling on the HV and DC Switchboards.

What attracted you to Balfour Beatty?
