My Individual Safety Commitment:

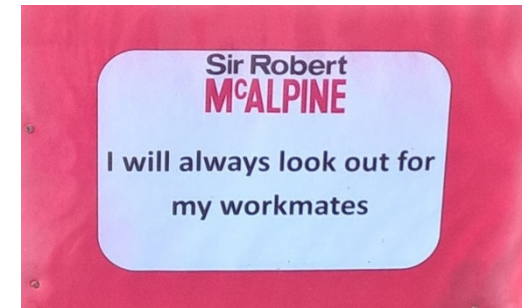
