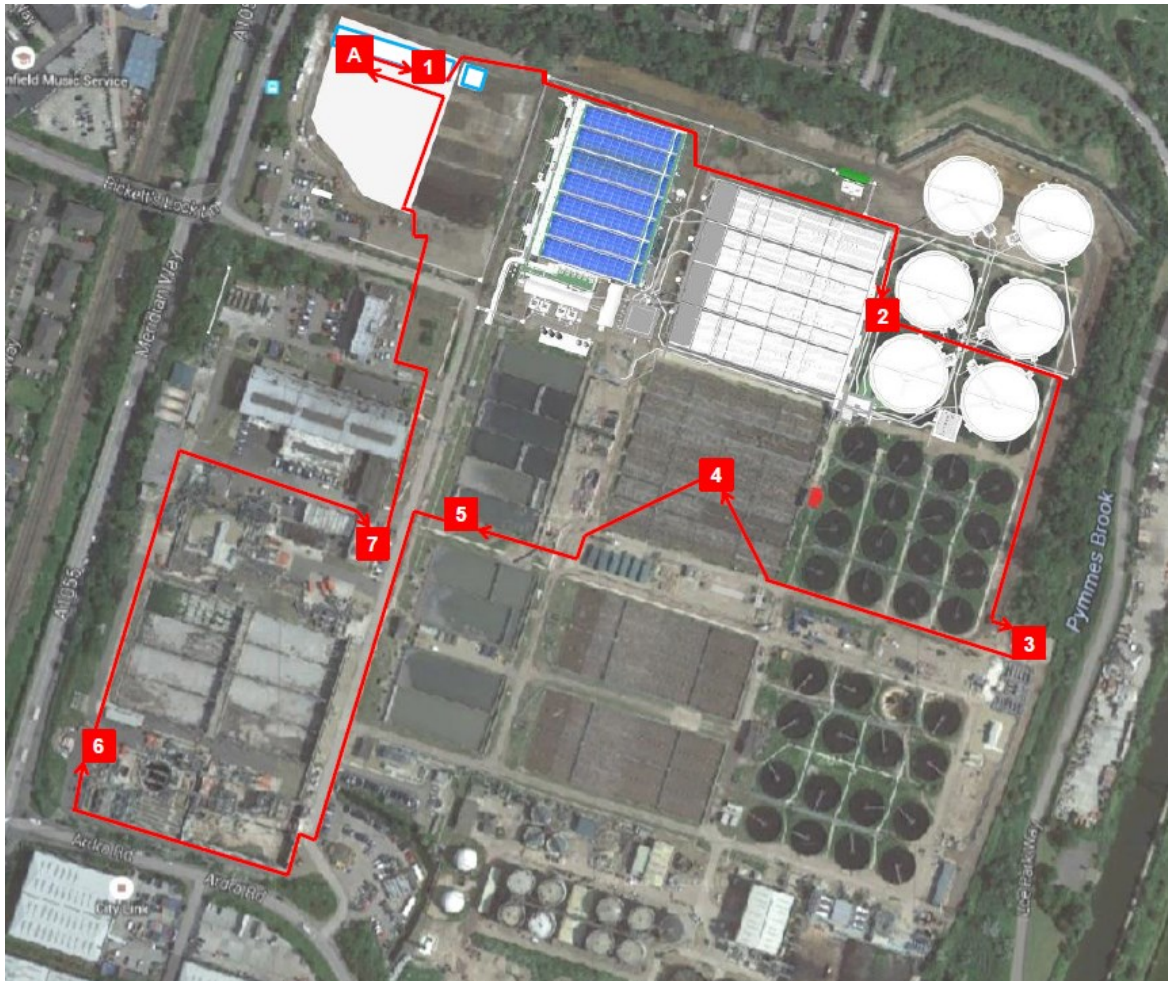


On Tuesday 2 May 2017, the 400 strong AMK team delivering the Upgrade of Deephams sewage treatment works for Thames Water, held its third Safety Engagement Day at Deephams. The day gives the team a chance to have a look at innovation in safety from suppliers, some safety demonstrations from the team's own experts and also to have a look at other progress on other sections of the works apart from their own.

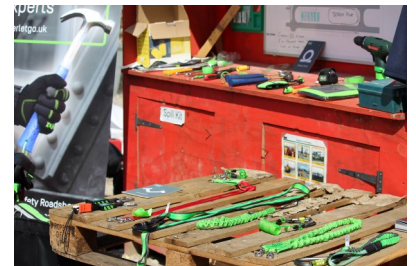
