Guidance Notes:			Confirm ✓
1 No HIAB must work on site unless all the appropriate certificates are with the crane and in order			
2 The weight of the load being lifting must be known.			
3 Ground conditions must be suitable for the weight of vehicle and load.			
4. Have you checked for any underground hazards? (Manholes, voids, trenches etc.)			
5 Outriggers must always be used and be adequately supported by steel / timber plates in good condition.			
6 Observe safe clearances of electric power cables.			
7 Are weather conditions suitable? (Wind speed, visibility, ice / snow)			
8 The Rated Capacity (SWL) is never exceeded.			
9 Check that there is adequate clearance around the slewing circle to prevent persons being trapped.			
10 When lifting, stop briefly when load is just off the ground / vehicle bed and check stability of vehicle.			
11 Has the correct lifting points been established. Slings protected from sharp edges?			
12 No load to be left suspended if HIAB is unattended.			
13 No lifting to be undertaken if operatives, banksmen or delivery drivers are not wearing mandatory PPE (Glasses, gloves, hard hat, Hi-Viz vest / jacket safety footwear.			
14 Are the slings in place for attaching hook from ground level? No one is allowed on the back of the vehicle without suitable & sufficient edge protection / fall arrest.			
15 Ensure slings are double wrapped if required prior to lifting?
