- Designated GBHP parking spaces are available in the **Park Centre**, Donegall Rd, Belfast BT12 6HN, a 5-10 min walk away from the site.
- From the M1 towards Belfast, exit at Junction 1. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit into the Park Centre.
- The GBHP Reserved Parking Spaces are located in Carpark C on the right-hand side, opposite the car wash, and behind the red/white barriers.
- Walk back out the Park Centre and keep left around the corner onto Broadway. Take the first right to enter the Royal Victoria Hospital.
